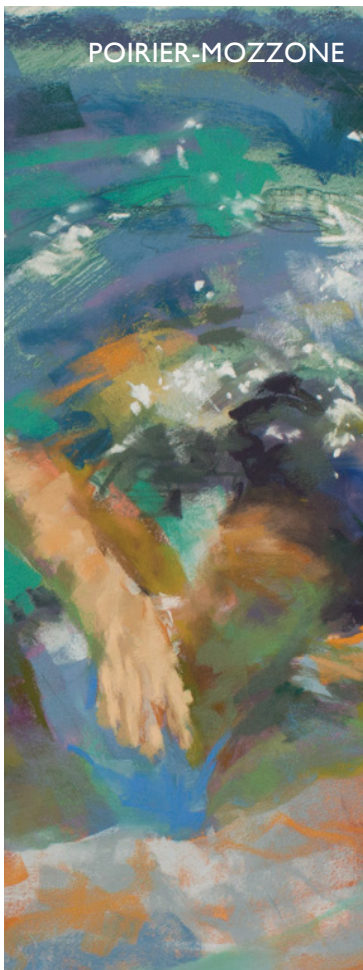
Show end: Artists may set up their art any time after 9:00 am the date of the show and break down their displays only after 8:30 pm on the date of the show and not before.
