The exhibition will run from March 28th to April 30th 2016. A reception with awards, music and refreshments will be held on April 9th from 5-7PM in the Community Hall of the Library. The competition is open to all artists; cash awards will be presented for the top ten pieces of art. A non-refundable entry fee of \$20 for one entry, \$30 for a maximum of two entries made payable to the Norfolk Cultural Council is required to be considered for the competition. Previous artwork from our 2014 competition may not be resubmitted. Applications with payment(check or money order) will be accepted between February 1st and 29th. 
