Drop-off: Wednesday, July 27th, 10am - 12pm at THE BLACK BOX.

Pick-up: Monday, Aug. 1st, 10am - 12pm at THE BLACK BOX.

Artwork Requirements: Work must be original (no copies or use of copyrighted work), and not previously exhibited at any FAA shows. Framed artwork maximum 16" in any direction. Entries must be properly framed (no clip-on frames, saw-tooth hooks, fish-line) wire only - ready for hanging. Frames, glass, mats must be not dirty, chipped, damaged, and no wet paint. Work NOT meeting these guidelines will be rejected at check in.

Labels: Please print labels. Your correct information is needed for panel labels and exhibit viewing booklet/program.

Send lower group of labels and waiver. Attach top group of labels to back of your artwork.
