

Treasurer's Report


As of March 25, 2023 the treasury consists of 2,943.37. (General Fund = 909.47; Scholarship Fund = 2,033.90).

During March the demonstration artist was paid. There were five memberships, and five workshop enrollments. The FAA has purchased a hanging system for our Gallery for \$ 985.00. This expense is expected to be fully reimbursed with a grant from the Franklin Cultural District, plus an "In Memory Of" donation. The Storage and Gallery fees for April still need to be paid. The Gallery fee will be decreased this coming month due to art work sales during March.

As a reminder, the Franklin Cultural Council / MA Cultural Council has awarded a \$ 1,600.00 grant for paying our monthly demonstrators during calendar year 2022. The FAA is still awaiting payment.


