Every now and then, I pull my volume of Robert Genn's "Letters" off the bookshelf. You can literally flip it open to any one of its 855 pages and find interesting musings on all things art-related! The letters in this book were written over a 10 year period from 1999 to 2009, which is now almost 25 years ago. But they are still just as relevant today as they were then.

A letter written on May 30, 2000 described the benefits of belonging to an art club. Robert wrote "Clubs engage speakers, teachers and demonstrators, and sometimes set up exhibitions in malls and church halls where members' work - which would not normally find its way into galleries - is profitably sold. Apart from the growth and learning potential plus mutual critiquing and support, clubs give people the opportunity to conduct meetings, prepare budgets, run galleries, buy wholesale and otherwise hob-nob with their fellow wizards." This has certainly been the case for me, and I hope for you as well!
