Entries: \$25 for up to 2 pieces. Check and entry form must be mailed to the Franklin Art Association, 279 East Central Street, PMB #289, Franklin MA 02038, firm postmarked deadline Monday April 9th

Drop-off: Saturday April 21 at 8:30 am, at THE BLACK BOX. Please note this applies to artwork, bins, bin work and small works.

Pick-up: Sunday, April 22 at 4 pm at THE BLACK BOX.

Artwork Requirements: Work must be original (no copies or use of copyrighted work), and not previously exhibited at any FAA shows. Framed artwork maximum width is 32", and height of 36". Entries must be properly framed (no clip-on frames, saw-tooth hooks, fish-line) wire only - ready for hanging. Frames, glass, mats must be not dirty, chipped, damaged, and no wet paint. Work NOT meeting these guidelines will be rejected at check in.

Commission: All work sold will be subject to 20% commission.

Bin Work: Bin can be solo or shared. Bin art must be unframed, in clear envelopes, and all bin/small works must be clearly priced, with artist name.

Small works: Hand painted work. Framed size maximum 8 x 10" (either direction), limit your pieces (space is limited, you may hold additional items in reserve to replenish); we reserve right to not include small works. Fine art objects, fine craft jewelry/pottery/objects as well as note cards, postcards, photos and original art prints are acceptable. Please name and price each item. Business cards welcomed. No solicitation of outside organizations.

Exhibit & Reception:ALL PARTICIPANTS Please bring finger food, snacks, bottled water, soft drinks, coffee/tea, (with set ups for same), for food table. Sign up for donating food can be made at FAA March and April monthly meetings.

Awards: Exhibit will be a judged exhibit, by outside area judge. There will be First, Second, Third, Honorable Mention ribbons given in each of the above categories. In addition, there will be Best of Show plus "People's Choice" award.

### Call for Entries

EXHIBITION: FRIDAY, APRIL 27 - SUNDAY, MAY 6, 2018 Live Art Event Saturday, April 28

Location: Franklin Public Library, 195 Main St., Franklin, MA

**Eligibility:** Open to all figurative artists. **All entered pieces must show figures in motion.** Entries must be original and completed in the last two years. Work must be properly framed or gallery wrapped (no clip-on frames or saw tooth hooks), ready for hanging with wire. Pieces must not exceed 24x32 inches, including frame. All work will be examined for these guidelines. Sculpture, photography, collage and digital art will <u>not</u> be accepted. The show reserves the right to reject any inappropriate submissions.

**Entries:** You many enter up to 2 pieces in the following categories: (1) Oil; (2) Acrylic; (3) Water media; (4) Pastel; (5) Drawing; (6) Mixed media

To enter: Fill out the entry form online at http://bit.ly/artist\_entry. Digital photos of your entries must be uploaded as part of your application. For accepted work, fill out and attach to the back of your work the identification labels on the following page.

**Entry fee:** There is no entry fee. This inaugural ArtWeek exhibition is being subsidized by the Town of Franklin.

Deadline: All entries are due no later than March 1, 2018. No exceptions.

**Live Art Event:** A group of exhibiting artists will paint and draw live performers as they are performing on Sat, April 28 from 2:00-4:00 pm, as part of Franklin ArtWeek. More detailed information below. Artists interested in participating in the Live Art Event must: indicate so on their entry form, upload a live model sketch example, and must be committed to attend.

Awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and People's Choice awards will be given

**Jurying:** This is a juried exhibition. The Franklin Cultural Council will choose selected works to exhibit. Artists will be notified of their acceptance no later than March 15. Your ability to participate in the Live Art Event on April 28 will be taken into account when selecting works.

**Commission:** By entering this exhibition, you agree to donate 20% of the purchase price of all artwork sold at the show to the Franklin Cultural Council.

Delivery: Drop-off is Thurs, April 26, from 12:00 - 7:00 p.m. at the Franklin Public Library.

Pick-up: Pick-up artwork Sun, May 6 between 3:30 - 4:30 p.m.

### ART IN MOTION LIVE ART EVENT DETAILS

The Franklin Cultural Council is accepting artists to participate in our *Act in Maxim Line Art Event* on Saturday, April 28 from 2:00–4:00 pm at the Franklin Public Library. Artists will paint and draw live performers as they are performing, while the general public watches. Sos performance slots will be awarded to local high school and college students, with 2 groups each of Dancers (in full costume), Musicians (in concert attire); and Actors (in full costume – period costumes preferred).

The performers will be given a 10 x 10' performance area. Artists will be placed in a circle around the performers. The general public may sit or walk behind the artists to watch. Each group will consist of 1-4 performers and will have a 15 minute performance planned. The performance may be one or multiple pieces to total the 15 minutes. Each drawing period will begin with a 2-3 minute static pose for the artists to sketch, followed by the performance. You may use any painting or drawing medium to sketch the performance. Artists must supply their own matarials.

One drawing by each artist from each 15 minute sitting must be denoted to the Frankhin Cultural Council. The denoted shetches will be offered at the event to the public in exchange for a monetary domation to the Library's program fund. All participants must be at least 14 years old and must sign a model release. Artists will be provided with a copy of the model releases so that they may keep, use, further develop, or sell the other works they create that day. Photos and a news article will be submitted to all local papers and particle office after the event

There is no fas to participate in the Live Art Event, through only artists whose work was accepted into the Art in Motion Exhibition may participate. Theference is given during jurying to those artists that are available for the Live Art Event, and, if selected, you must commit to attend. A digital sample of a quick-live model sketch you completed should be upleaded with your entry form.

The *Art in Motion Live Art Event* is part of Franklin ArtWeek. ArtWeek is a state wide arts and cultural. festical April 27-May 6, 2018. For more information on ArtWeek, visit them online at www.artweekma.org.
