Can you believe it's the holidays already? Between turkey, and gift shopping, and parties, and family, I'm guessing you're as busy this time of year as I am—so try to take a few minutes here and there to express your creativity and get a little "down" time. You'll be glad you did.

We ended the fall with a bang. Thanks so much to all of you—and especially to Paul & Tina Guarino-for the incredibly hard work and dedication that went into the Fall Into Art Festival. I was delighted to see what a great success the show turned out to be. Many said that it was the best show we had done yet—what a thrill! The Gala was wonderful, with standing-room-only crowds and lots of non-members in attendance. We had over 250 visitors on Saturday alone—which is usually the max we get for the whole weekend. So kudos to all of you! The sales were as good as the crowds. I believe we collected more in almost every single area than we ever have before. Silent Auction sales doubled over last year, at \$658. The raffle brought in \$200 more than last year, for a total of \$737. Entry fees and artwork commissions were also high, at \$1120 and \$1027, respectively. Our final revenue, including sponsorship dollars? A whopping \$6,172! Even with higher costs this year, we still added \$2,503 to our bottom line—almost \$2,000 more than in 2007 (which was a profitable year!). Thank you again to all who made this possible.

So take a deep breath, relax a little at our FAA Holiday Party on Dec. 4, and start 2009 with a smile on your face. I know I will.
