The venue was terrific, the hosts couldn't have been more supportive, the food was great, the FHS Chamber Orchestra was a very nice addition, the wine bar was nice, but mostly it was the fine artwork that stole the show. What wonderful talent! There were 175 pieces of work, with 60 artists participating. That is a new FAA record. Congratulations to all those who received special recognition and to everyone who shared the gift of their art with all of us.

With Thanksgiving rapidly approaching, what a perfect time to give a special thanks to all of you who made the show such a success. Special thanks to the show committee, Paul Peterson, Gail Eckberg, Jean White, Dick Fotland and a very special thanks to Paul Guarino for his tireless work in obtaining the venue and for obtaining sponsorships in these tough economic times - a real tribute to his ability to gently persuade folks how important it is to support the arts in your local community. And to Tina Guarino for putting together the FHS student art work - a terrific way to link FAA to the community and to provide an opportunity for our young artists to show their work in a public forum.

And thanks to all the folks who contributed in so many ways - the food, the publicity, the signage, the flyers and postcards, the donated services and items, the brochure and labels, the hanging/take down, the check-in, the cash table, the silent auction, and the raffle... and on and on. Great job!!

The final financial report has not been completed yet, however, I can positively say that this show was a huge success for FAA artists and for the organization. We will be able to replenish the scholarship account through raffle sales which were about \$1075, enabling us to fund the annual scholarship this year. Preliminary figures show \$730 in silent auction sales, and over \$4000 in art sales! Most of the show expenses should be covered by the generous donations. Payments will be going out to artists as soon as all the figures and credit card amounts are finalized.


At the November meeting FAA members were treated to a visit by artist Maris Platais, who did a demonstration in acrylic paint.
